Suffolk County Transit will soon be launching a mobile ticketing application that will allow riders to purchase fares through their smartphone.

The County is seeking public input on the fares to be made available through this application.

It is proposed that full fares, student fares, and reduced fares shall be made available, at their current cash prices, in packages of 2 tickets, 5 tickets, and 20 tickets. Riders would receive one free fare with the purchase of a 20 ticket package. Riders can also opt to add transfers to their fare package.

Interpreter services will be made available to deaf persons or non-English speakers, at no charge, upon written request submitted no later than 10 days prior to the scheduled public hearing. The written request must be sent to Chris Chatterton, Principal Transportation Planner, at the address noted below.

Written testimony may be submitted both before and up to five (5) days following the hearing by mail to the address noted below and shall be added to the public record of this hearing.
